Danny's Global Walk will be at the Embassy's in Washington, D.C. on September 10 and in New York City at Ground Zero for a program the evening of September 11. From there he flies to Alaska and begins his walk south along the Pan American Highway until he nears the tip of South America and then on to Africa, the Middle East and completes this walk at the opening ceremony of the 2008 Olympics in Beijing, China.

Jackie Charsagua, Chief Operating Officer of Global Walk is a Leesburg resident, recently retired from the Air Force as a Lt. Col. Her daughter, also named Jackie attended Simpson Middle School during the past school year and now anticipates a unique opportunity to continue her schooling as she travels the world.
